### **Jillings Award in Psychology Terms of Reference**

1. The purpose of the Jillings Award is to recognize an individual(s) who has made outstanding contributions towards excellence in psychology in Saskatchewan.
2. The award will be presented as a one-time career award.
3. All Saskatchewan residents are eligible to receive the award.
4. Nominations will be solicited from the Saskatchewan community annually.
5. Potential award recipients will be nominated by Saskatchewan residents, in writing. Each nominee must be nominated by two individuals. The nominee will consent to the nomination. Nomination forms are available from PAS and on the website.
6. A selection committee consisting of PAS Executive Council members or representatives will select the nominee or nominees who are to be awarded the Jillings award and their recommendation will go to PAS Executive Council for ratification. The selection committee will give particular consideration to nominations received from the psychological community in Saskatchewan. PAS president, president-elect, and past president will not be eligible for receipt of the award in the years they serve their terms as executive on PAS Executive Council.
7. The recipient will be notified prior to the awards presentation.
8. The award shall be presented annually at the PAS Annual General Meeting (AGM) or other suitable PAS programs, events or functions.
9. Reasonable travel expenses may be covered for the nominee to attend the ceremony.
10. The award itself shall consist of an engraved plaque or an alternative suitable for public display, as well as a letter of congratulations from the PAS president outlining the recipients' contribution based on the information provided with the nomination form.
